CHOOSE AN END!





Content Audio-visual texts with two possible endings (e.g. a sad ending and a happy ending)

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- answer questions about a short video
- summarize the content of the video in their own words

- are divided into two groups: remote and classroom learners
- each group watches a version of the video with a different ending
- in small groups (in class or in breakout rooms) discuss the questions related to their version of the video
- summarize the video for the other half of the class

TEACHING ACTIVITIES

- allow learners to choose which ending they would like to watch
- pre-teach necessary vocabulary if required
- encourage students to predict what they think will happen before watching
- show the video two or three times
- facilitate the discussion in small groups
- mingle to check understanding during the discussion
- ask for volunteers to summarize the videos
